Role: One to one Kernow Connect sessional worker

Main Purpose:

To deliver one to one sessions, either face to face or online if required, to young people aged over eleven years, identified through referral to 'Kernow Connect', across Cornwall at a specified venue.

Method:

Providing a safe confidential environment for young people to explore their thoughts, feelings and emotions. Working within a person centred philosophy offering empathy and unconditional acceptance to all. Using creative approaches to engage young people and empower them to make decisions for themselves.

Main Responsibilities:

- To work on a one to one basis with young people either face to face or online if required
- To work at all times within a person centred philosophy and ethical framework
- To use creative arts to engage young people
- To support young people to make informed choice
- To empower young people
- To build trusting relationships
- Be a positive role model
- Provide a safe confidential environment
- Maintain confidentiality at all times
- Pass on safeguarding concerns
- Attend specified venues as required (ability to travel Countywide essential)
- Be an ambassador for the Charity at all times
- Have flexibility in working hours
- Attend regular supervision
- Keep accurate records
- Attend training as required
- To work at all times within Charity policies.
- To keep up to date with changes in Charity policies (with particular reference to COVID safety guidelines)
- Other duties, commensurate with the post, that may arise from time to time, at the discretion of the Work Practice Manager / CEO.
